### Semester 3

#### **NUR198** *Adult Health Nursing I*

- On Campus Lab: 10 hours
- On Campus Simulation: 20 hours

#### **NUR234** *Maternal Newborn Nursing*

- On Campus Simulation: 10.5 hours

**Semester 3 Lab and Simulation Schedule:** Students will complete in-person skills development generally over a 5-day period at the Draper, Utah campus.

### Semester 4

#### **NUR258** *Adult Health Nursing II*

- On Campus Simulation: 20 hours

**Semester 4 Simulation Schedule:** Students will complete in-person skills development generally over a 2-day period at the Draper, Utah campus.

### About Labs and Simulation

Colorado students will attend in-person labs and simulations at the Joyce Johnson Center of Simulation in the Draper, Utah campus. These will generally occur over several consecutive days during the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th semesters. Dates and times are determined during registration.
